## 2026 Carbon County Fair Camping Rules

*Rules of the camper space policy are subject to change year to year*

1. The ZERO tolerance of inappropriate behavior will be enforced!
2. Size limit: trailers cannot exceed the marked parking spaces, or you will have to move.
3. Size limit: Spaces 14-30 are limited to a trailer no more than 26' long.
4. Please do not change your trailer size after you have submitted your application.
5. NO holes may be dug to level your trailer. Bring your blocks with you! A fee of \$100 and loss of future trailer space privileges will be charged for tearing up the grass during any setup procedure.
6. Fee for numerically identified electrical space is \$60. No others will be allowed to run electrical cords.
7. Fee for non-electrical spaces north of the Harshman St. gate is \$30. Contestant's Row spaces are \$30. Tags (pick up at the fair office) must be attached to the trailer for the entire week, or the trailer will be towed.
8. Handicap spaces are available upon request for \$60.
9. The fair board does not condone drinking by minors. Adults staying on grounds are asked to report violators to security which will have instructions to prosecute.
10. Tents marked on the application will be allowed only with the permission of the fair board. Tags (pick up at the fair office) must remain attached to the tent for the entire week.
11. Trailer spaces are awarded on an annual basis and are assigned by luck of the draw.
12. Only one space per family is allowed. All applicants must have a member enrolled in a 4-H or FFA livestock project.
13. No applicant may specify a specific trailer space assignment or neighbor.
14. Applications received after the deadline will be assigned only as space allows.
15. Only superintendents may park in the superintendents' row north of the small animal barn.
16. Once a trailer is parked on the lawn, all vehicles are to be removed until the trailer is to be taken home.
17. There will be a midnight curfew.
18. An adult chaperone must be present and staying all week in the registered trailer. A list of all occupants of each trailer and/or tent must be submitted with the application. Please report all changes.
19. No trailers will be allowed on the grass until Sunday, August 2, 2026. Bicycles are allowed in the parking lot only.
20. Licensed 4-Wheelers/Side by Sides are allowed in the parking lot only with a licensed driver.
21. Dogs must be leashed at all times and may not be taken into any building, barn or grandstands.
22. NO open containers in the camping area after 10 p.m.
